

ORDINANCE NO. 684

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE COMMERCE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING CHAPTER 2.13 (ELECTION DATES) TO TITLE 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 36503, a general municipal election shall be held on a date prescribed by Section 1301 of the Elections Code;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code section 1301(a), a general municipal election shall be held on an established election date pursuant to Elections Code section 1000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Election Code section 1000 (c), one of the established election dates is the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June of each year; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to schedule its general municipal elections to be on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June in odd numbered years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 36937, an ordinance takes effect immediately if it is an ordinance relating to an election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 2.13 (Election Dates) is hereby added to Title 2 (Administration and Personnel) of the Commerce Municipal Code to read as follows:


“Chapter 2.13 – Election Dates.

General Municipal Elections in the City of Commerce shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June in odd numbered years.”

Section 2. Pursuant to Government Code section 36937, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, assign it the next number in order, and thereupon and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
