

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND REVIEW  
OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 44<sup>th</sup> YEAR  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS  
(CDBG 2018-2019)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Commerce has prepared a substantial amendment to its 44<sup>th</sup> Community Development Block Grant Program (2018-2019). The publication of this notice is the beginning of the 30-day public review period. The public review and written comment period begins September 6, 2018 and runs through October 16, 2018.

The Substantial Amendment will be presented to the City Council for approval on the following date:

At this meeting, the City Council will conduct a Public Hearing to receive public comment on the 2018-2019 Substantial Amendment that will subsequently be considered for approval and then submitted to the Los Angeles County Community Development Commission (LACDC).

**SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT**

The Substantial Amendment includes the cancellation of the City's ADA Accessibility Improvements – Curb Ramps in Bristow/Northwest Area (601990-18) and the reallocation of this project's funding of \$111,832 and allocation of \$3,809 of rollover funds, as a result of unexpended 2017-2018 for a total of \$115,641, to the City's existing Home Preservation Grant Program (601074-17). The Home Preservation Grant Program's total funding amount will be increased to \$210,641 for FY 2018-2019.

The public is invited to submit written comments on the Substantial Amendment identified herein. All comments regarding the Amendment should be submitted to the City of Commerce's Public Works and Development Services Department no later than 5:00 p.m. on October 16, 2018.
