A ready room is available for classroom instruction or casual occupancy and features a television with VCR/DVD setup for member's convenience.

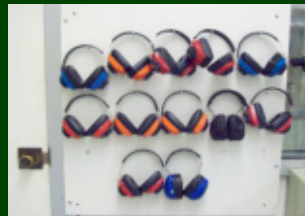

- Is between the ages of 12 to 20
- Has a signed parent/guardian consent form
- Completes our firearm safety course
- Pays the one time \$5 membership fee

All equipment is provided free of charge to our junior members by the City of Commerce. Juniors only shoot with range rifles.

Firearm Safety Course

Safety courses are taught by our Range Staff who have been certified by the National Rifle Association (NRA) in the rifle and pistol disciplines. Our knowledgeable staff has over a hundred years combined firearm and shooting experience to help guide you through our 3-hour course and give you a better understanding of the fundamentals of firearm handling and shooting.

Individuals or groups interested in learning how to shoot or refine their abilities may schedule an appointment with one of our Range Staff. Firearms and ammunition are provided with the course. No one under the age of 21 will be permitted to shoot a pistol.

For Your Safety

Our range is operated as a private membership facility for City of Commerce residents and Commerce industrial employees. A firearm safety course is required for all new memberships.
