## **Title VI Policy**

The City of Commerce Transportation Department are committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, or denied the benefits of its services on the basis of race, color or national origin as protected by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended. No person or group of persons will be discriminated against with regard to routing, scheduling, or quality of transportation service that Commerce furnishes, on the basis of race, color, or national origin.

Frequency of service, age and quality of Commerce vehicles assigned to routes, and location of routes will not be determined on the basis of race, color or national origin.

Any person who believes that he or she has, individually, or as a member of any specific class of persons, been subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin may file a Title VI complaint with the City of Commerce. The complaint must be filed within 180 days of the date of the alleged discrimination.
